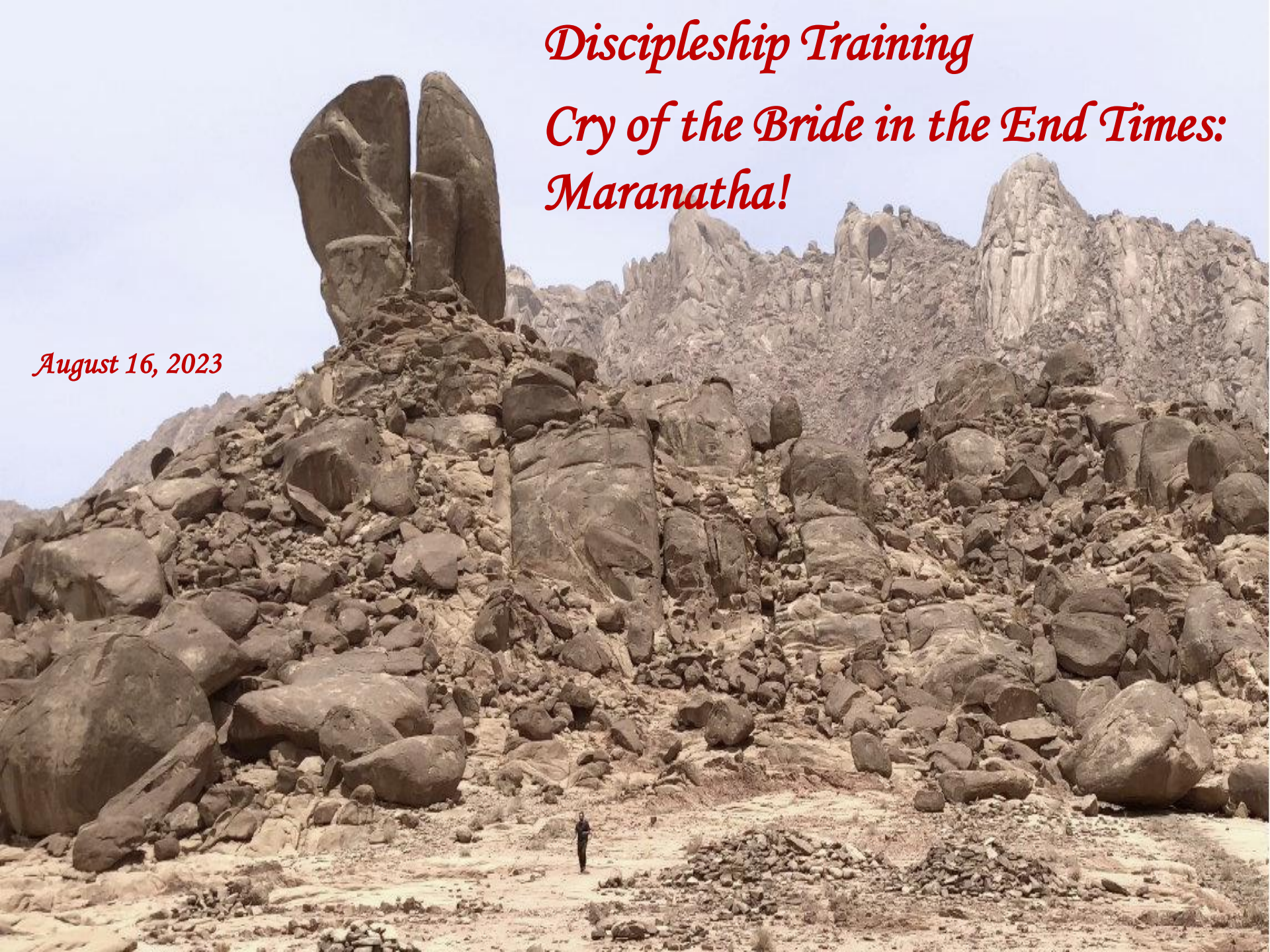


Your takes will focus on Jacob's trouble according to at least 2-3 prophets, Angel Gabriel or Jesus.



Jeremiah 30:4-7

“This is the message the Lord gave concerning Israel and Judah. This is what the Lord says: “I hear cries of fear; there is terror and no peace. Now let me ask you a question: Do men give birth to babies? Then why do they stand there, ashen-faced, hands pressed against their sides like a woman in labor? In all history there has never been such a time of terror. It will be a time of trouble for my people Israel. Yet in the end they will be saved!”

 - **But there will be a remnant of Jacob (Israel) there will be salvation for them.**




Daniel 12:1-2 NLT

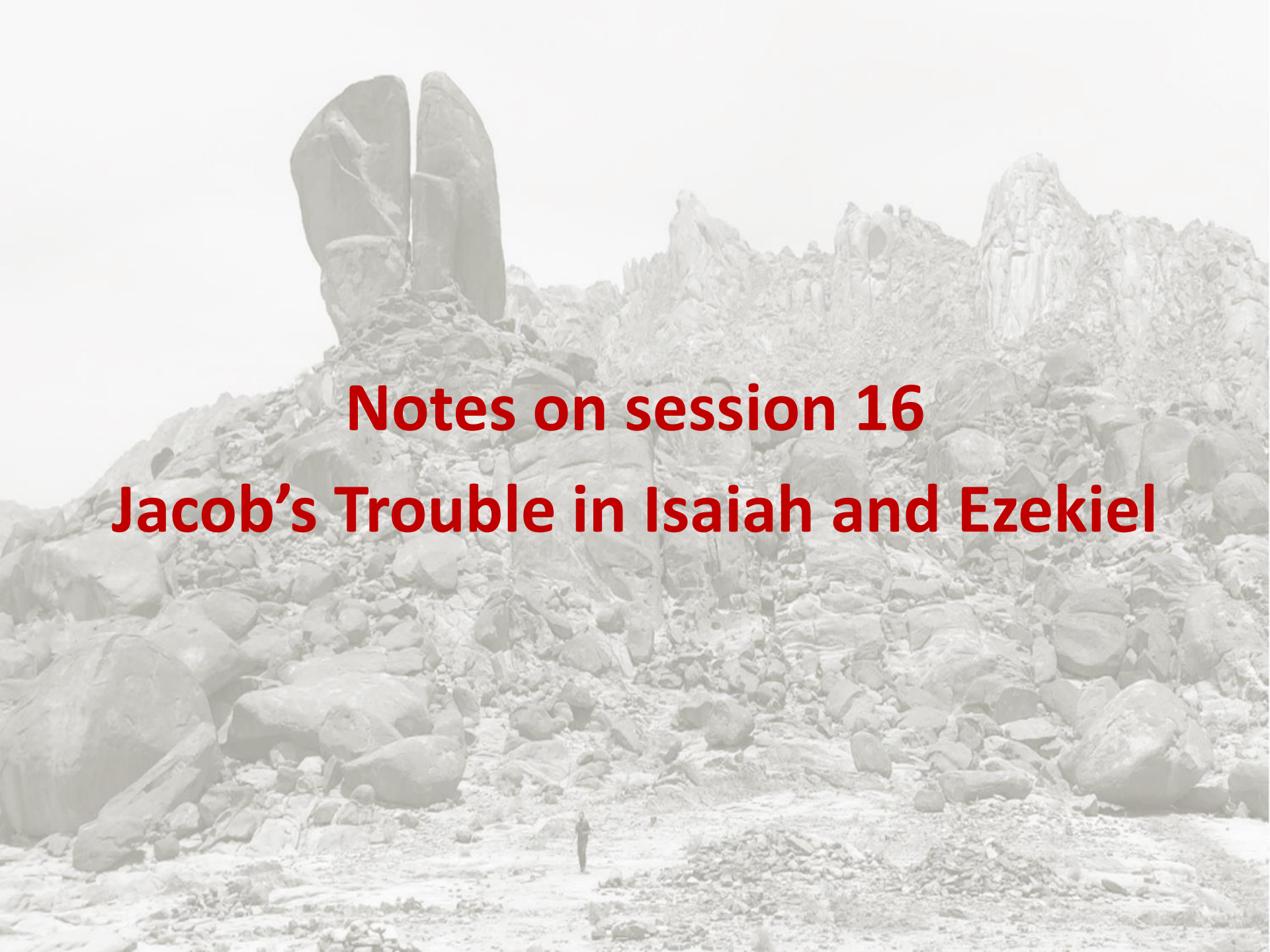
““At that time Michael, the archangel who stands guard over your nation, will arise.

Jacob's Trouble in Isaiah and Ezekiel



On the day you were born, you were unwanted, dumped in a field and left to die. “But I came by and saw you there, helplessly kicking about in your own blood.


As you lay there, I said, ‘Live!’ And when I passed by again, I saw that you were old enough for love.


Ezekiel 16:8 NLT

In fact, unless that time of calamity is shortened, not a single person will survive.


But it will be shortened for the sake of God’s chosen ones.”
