Episode 17: ISRAEL'S RESTORATION ACCORDING TO MOSES

- Israel's salvation: The final cycle will not be complete until Israel is fully restored - both to the physical land and to the Lord.
- Israel's final restoration to the land will be accompanied by the following realities
 - national repentance
 - the outpouring of God's Spirit on all of Israel's survivors
 - the return and enthronement of the King Messiah
- important to note that none of these things may be said concerning Israel's re-establishment in 1948

Episode 17: ISRAEL'S RESTORATION ACCORDING TO MOSES

- The scriptures teach that the return to the land will not just be revival of Jewish nationalism; It will be a spiritual revival if the whole nation, a complete return to the Lord forever
- MOSES
 - Deuteronomy 4:29-31
 - Deuteronomy 30:1-6
- Part of our mandate as Gentile believers is to remind the Jewish people of these very things to posses something signifies permanence
- Deuteronomy 32:37-39 in the aftermath of the holocaust, the corporate cry that arose from the Jewish nation was one of Self-sufficiency and strength versus dependence upon the Lord

Episode 18: Israel's salvation according to the prophets

The Prophets: Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel

Isaiah 60: one of the most beautiful, detailed vision of the messianic kingdom after the return of Jesus - Jesus ruling from Zion on the throne. It describes the nation's streaming to Jerusalem to worship the King.

With Isaiah 60 is Isaiah 59

Isaiah 59:20-21: For those who repent, a redeemer will come to Jerusalem

- these verses were one of the earliest and clearest Descriptions of the new covenant prophesied in Old Testament
- the fulfillment of The Mosaic covenant will not happen apart from the new
- all 3 big prophets prophesied the new covenant ... not just a Concept
- in this passage we see the following:
 - coming of the Messiah
 - National repentance of Israel
 - Restoration to the land
 - new covenant of the Spirit

Jeremiah 30:8-11 "David their King" refers to the Son of David, Jesus Christ

The language of restoration, etc. happens within a brief period of time, within the context of Jesus's return

- Jeremiah 31:27-34 The last days are a greater version of the exodus; the exodus is a pattern for the ultimate deliverance and redemption to come
 - analogies are used to communicate intimacy
 - The ultimate reality of which is this: "I will be their God, and they will be my people "
- Ezekiel 34:23-27 Written hundreds of years before David, it was always understood that the Son of David would be the Messiah, Israel's King
 - The covenant of peace is more than solely salvation;
 - Israel's restoration to the land and her salvation are mutually entwined
- Ezekiel echoes what the other prophets said; Israel will know that God is the Lord after He delivers them from slavery

Ezekiel 36:23-31

Not only does Israel come to know the Lord, also those who are left among the nations after His judgments

Again we will see the following:

- the coming of the Messiah
- Israel's national repentance
- restoration to the land
- the new covenant
- the outpouring of His Spirit on Israel
