Blessings in Obedience & Punishments in Disobedience

Blessings of Obedience (Verses 1-13)

”I will live among you, and
I will not despise you.
I will walk among you;
I will be your God, and
you will be my people.

I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt so you would no longer be their slaves. I broke the yoke of slavery from your neck so you can walk with your heads held high.“

Leviticus 26:11-13 NLT

“I’ll set up my residence in your neighborhood;
I won’t avoid or shun you; I’ll stroll through your streets.
I’ll be your God; you’ll be my people.

I am God, your personal God who rescued you from Egypt so that you would no longer be slaves to the Egyptians.

I ripped off the harness of your slavery so that you can move about freely.“

Leviticus 26:11-13 MSG

Punishment for Disobedience (Verses 14-44)

Yet God says this in verse 45:

“But for their sake I will remember the covenant of their ancestors, whom I brought out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the nations, that I might be their God: I am the Lord.”

Leviticus 26:45 NKJV
